



# MANIFEST 2002

## Traders' Code of Conduct

1. \$60 entitles you to the hire of one 180 x 76 cm trestle table to be supplied by the Manifest Committee for the duration of Manifest. Only two trestle tables may be hired at a time. (Size is approximate at this time)
2. The Manifest Committee has defined an area for traders to set up in. Placement within this area is on a first come, first served basis although the Committee believes there are no superior positions. The Manifest Committee reserves the right to place those traders as they see fit in an alternate position.
3. Displays shall be limited to the area of the table. They may extend below and above the table but may not take up more floor space than has been hired. Hired floor space may not be divided.
4. Tables shall be placed on angles in accordance with the Manifest Committee's floor plan. The Manifest Committee reserves the right to realign tables and limit display areas during the festival.
5. The Manifest Committee or designated representatives decision in regards to table positioning and displays are final.
6. Storage - the Manifest Committee may provide Saturday night storage for goods but no responsibility is taken for the loss or damage of goods.
7. Tables may be attended by two people per table although during set up and tear down times this number may double. Those people attending table(s) should display their Manifest Trader Membership at all times.
8. Trader Memberships do not give Full (General) Membership rights. If a Trader wishes to participate in Manifest activities outside of trading they must become a general member.
9. Exchange between Dealer representatives is allowed.
10. Refunds - In the event that a Trader cannot attend their deposit and hire money will be refunded so long as they notify the Manifest Committee at least 2 weeks (10 working days) before Manifest commences.
11. Manifest is a non profit festival that seeks to bring anime to the general community.
12. Traders are also bound by the Manifest Attendees' Code of Conduct.
13. Decisions by the Manifest Committee or their designated representative are final.

14. Designated Representative for 2002 is Rebekah Webb.
