

Manifest Dress Code

Policy

All attendees and convention staff are required to conform to the dress code guidelines below. Failure to adhere to this may result in entry being refused, or being removed from the convention. This dress code is to ensure compliance with occupational health and safety standards.

Guidelines

Membership Badges must be worn at all times. Badges must be worn with their lanyard around the neck and clearly visible to all attendees and all staff members.

Footwear must be worn at all time.

Attendees and convention staff must not be scantily clothed.

Attendees and convention staff wearing a costume must ensure that there are no sharp edges, projecting shoulders or other additions to a costume that presents possible issues for the wearer or those around the wearer.

Attendees and convention staff with costumes that are bulky, difficult to maneuver, restrict vision, or have mascot-type heads are required to travel with an unencumbered escort (someone in no costume or one without any restricting features).

Items or costume elements that may be offensive, disruptive, or dangerous are not allowed, and anyone wearing them may be asked by Manifest staff to remove or cover up questionable items.
